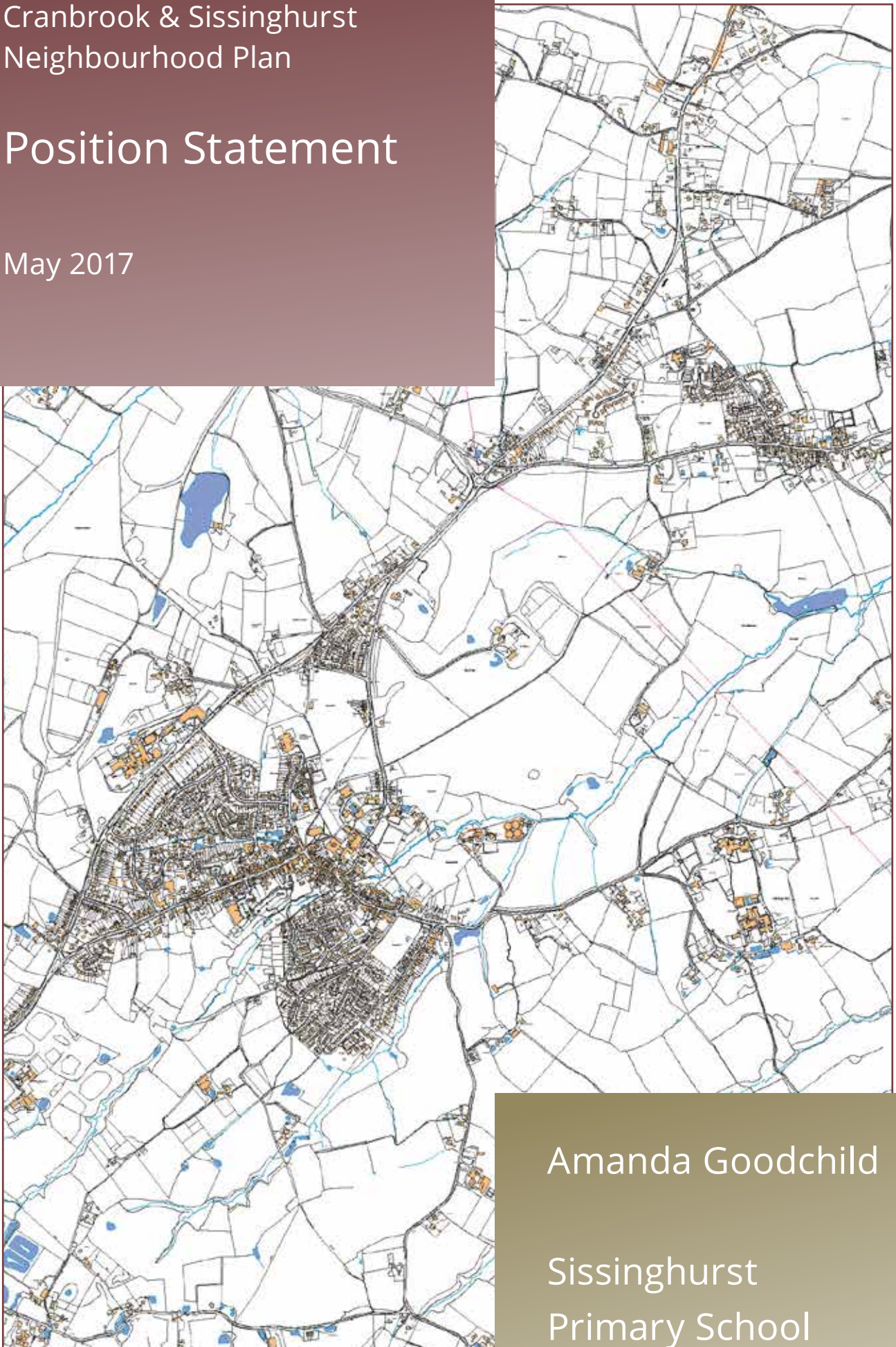

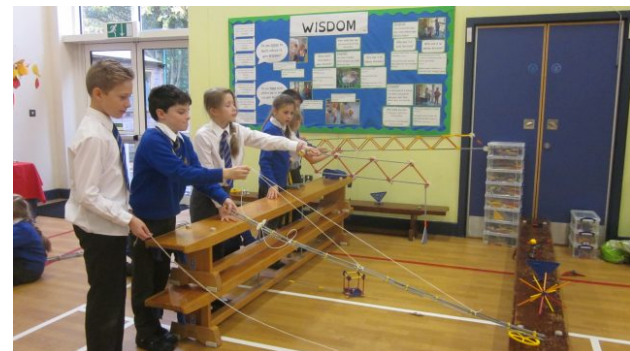
- Located in Common Road since 2011

1. Safety and school accessibility during the build, particularly during peak times.
2. Safety, transport and parking post-build.
3. Hoping to engage developers directly as well as in the submission process.
